

COP 26 Glasgow 2021

From Sunday 31st October – Friday 12th

November 14000 people at any one time.

- This will affect the M8, M80, M74 & M77.
- The Clyde side Expressway will be closed at 9am from Saturday 23rd October - Monday 15th November at 6am.
- M8 roadworks will still be in place. Junction 17 woodside (Viaduct)

- The Clyde Tunnel will be busier than usual. Both directions from Clyde side / M8 – Queen Elizabeth

Saturday 6th November

- Mass rally of 100,000 people in the city centre

- Major disruption exp extending to Anniesland, Maryhill, Cardonald, Pollockshields, Govan, Dalmarnock
- Monday 1st November is expected to be the busiest day from Finneston, Yorkhill and Kelvingrove (Significant disruption)

Sunday 10th October

Congress road – SEC/

Crowne Plaza will be closed and re-opened on Wednesday 17th November.

Sunday 24th October Congress Way, Finneston Quay, Tunnel St, Stobcross Road will all be closed till Sunday 21st November.

- Finneston St will be closed on Thursday 28th October till Sunday 15th November (Local access only from Saturday 23rd October).
